SUPER SCIENCE SHOW WITH NANO GIRL

On Tuesday August 11, the students were treated to a "Super Science Hero Show Spectacular" hosted by Dr Kate Sparks, a science educator better known as "Nano Girl". The show was delivered entirely with breath-taking experiments and clever engineering demonstrations.

The opening scene enthralled the students when "Nano Girl" set fire to the bubbles in her hand! The show was non-stop, with many surprising moments. There were several opportunities for our students to assist "Nano Girl" on stage. Even Miss Edinberry dauntlessly rode on the hover board powered by a leaf blower!.

Each part of the demonstration explained a concept including the super science of balloons, the power of super breath and air pressure, the science of levitation and the principles of aerodynamics to demonstrate flight.
